Friends and Family,

Joining Drive-In Ministries is a HUGE step of faith for Dana and me. The Vice-President position will get us fully involved in all aspects of the ministry locally, nationally, and internationally. Locally, we are helping oversee the



ministry at Drive-In Park in Prattville, AL, both with planning and development. There are BIG goals set in place for the park, from building a new headquarters building that would allow us to have ministry opportunities year-round, to replacing aging playground equipment. While we are very involved in activities there, our work does not take away from the other missionaries' duties there. We are praying that, with more hands helping and the Lord's guidance, it can be more fruitful than it has already been. Last year, the park team met for 27 movie nights and reached 1,611 people with 122 decisions for Christ. We are not just seeing people come to Christ, but we are also building relationships with them.

Nationally, Drive-In has partnered with a few organizations in the United States. We will be helping to grow those relationships and ministries. Our help comes in the form of movie events involving a mobile unit. A mobile unit consists of a 15-passenger van outfitted with a retractable movie screen, projector, sound system, and generator allowing the Gospel to be taken wherever needed.

Internationally, Drive-In has 11 different partners in nine different countries. These partners are out sharing the Gospel more than 40 weeks a year in Guatemala, Haiti, India, Mexico, Nigeria, and Romania. The partnerships look similar

overall with each having a mobile unit to use, but they each have different needs. One of the largest needs right now comes from Nigeria where an aging mobile unit is starting to need more repairs than can be reasonably done and, therefore, the unit will need replacing at a cost of \$50,000 for a new van and equipment. Rev. George Adeniyi with Gospel Faith Mission International travels 40+ weeks a year sharing the Gospel in 2-5 day long crusades reaching 20,000- 30,000 people each year. Typically, these efforts see 2,000-3,000 people trusting Christ as Lord and Savior. Our ministry's work will focus on nurturing relationships with partners and helping them obtain the supplies they need to continue sharing the Gospel.





While we are new to the mission field, we were blessed that our sending church agreed with us and our call to mission work. On January 21, 2024, Heritage Baptist Church in Prattville, held a commissioning service where the church came together to formally proclaim their support and pray for us and the work we are doing. We were also blessed in that many close and extended family and friends were able to attend.

We are excited to see how God will use our work with Drive-In Ministries to grow and change us. However, we still have things that are holding us back from our goal of full-time mission work. While David is blessed to be able to keep his full-time job in

construction, which provides for our current financial needs, it takes 50 or more hours a week due to the work schedule and two hours of daily commuting. For us to become full-time missionaries, we need financial support from our brothers and sisters in Christ. We have started the process of raising financial support and are thankful to have received support from 20 different families, but we still need your help. We need help financially, but we also need help through prayer. Prayer and the Lord's guidance have led us this far and we pray that the Lord will keep planning our steps for many years to come.
